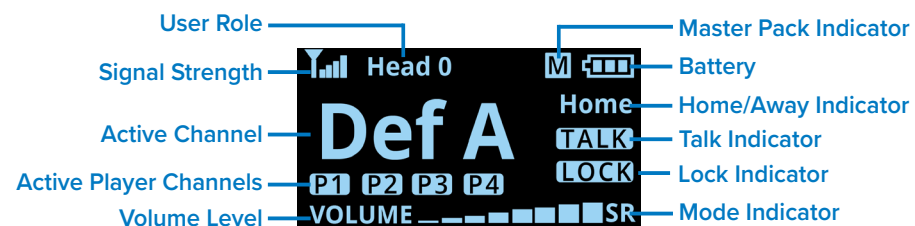


OVERVIEW

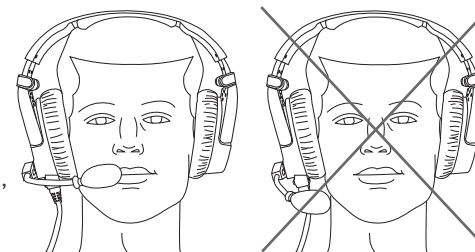


SETUP AND OPERATION

1 Connect a headset (if using a backpack).

Be sure to fully insert the headset connector.

For best performance, always wear the headset mic directly in front of your mouth, about a finger's width from your lips.

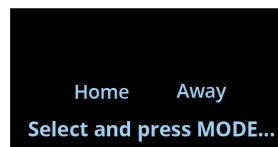


2 Power on the backpack or all-in-one headset.

Hold down the power button for 3 seconds, until the screen turns on.

3 On the Master backpack or all-in-one headset, select Home if you are the home team or Away if you are the visiting team.

Use the +/- buttons to toggle between the options. (Selected option will blink.) Press and hold the mode button to save your selection.



This setting provides proper wireless coordination for your other backpacks and between your team and another CoachComm Cobalt or Cobalt PLUS team.

4 Adjust volume as needed with the +/- buttons.

5 Maintain optimal line of sight with other backpacks and all-in-one headsets.

The "Head 0" pack is the Master (identified with "M" on the OLED) and is required for all packs to work. For best system performance, use the Master on the sideline near other packs.

6 Separate Offense and Defense backpacks and all-in-one headsets in the booth.

In the booth, separate your Offense backpacks from your Defense backpacks as much as possible. CoachComm recommends spacing them at least 5 feet apart.

7 Press the talk button to switch talk on and off.

Or press *and hold* the talk button if you are a Shared Talk user (Offense S or Defense S).

8 Short-press the channel button to cycle between the coaches' enabled Talk channels.

* Only one Offense Shared Talk user and one Defense Shared Talk user can talk at a time.
 ** Shared Talk IDs (OS and OR) cannot be used at the same time as the last Offense/Defense full-duplex IDs.

9 After The Game

Power off all backpacks and all-in-one headsets (hold down the power button). Thoroughly dry off any moisture. Properly stow away all gear in your case.

Be sure to fully charge your backpacks and all-in-one headsets after each use. (BeltPack charge time: 3.5 hours from dead with USB cable. 6.5 hours from dead with drop-in charger (sold separately).) When charging, LED is red. When charge complete, LED is off.
